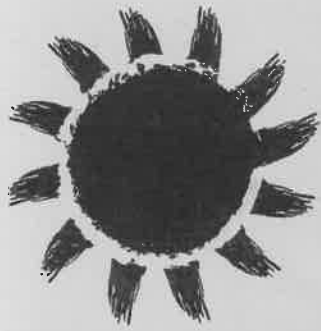

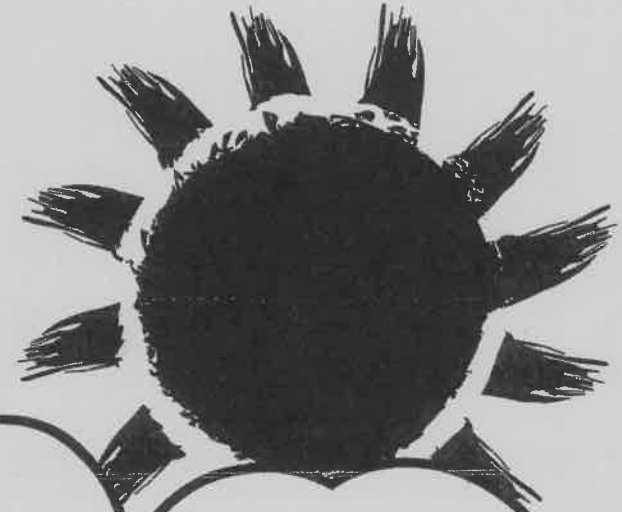


# UNITY/LUCK SUMMER SCHOOL 2018

Unity and Luck School Districts are creating a combination of classes that will include project-based academic enrichment, and also offer activities designed to instill a love for learning and discovery as we tap into student interests. Let's and have fun! Summer School will be broken down into two sessions this year. While all five weeks will run as a Creativity Academy, there are two weeks in June and three in July. Students can sign up for individual weeks, the June session, the July session, or all five weeks. Each week students will participate in one elective course and swimming. The dates for the June Creativity Academy are June 18<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup>. The July sessions of Summer School will be the weeks of July 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>-26<sup>th</sup>. For both sessions, Summer School will run Monday-Thursday from 8:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m. Students in grades 5-8 will participate in swimming during each week of Summer School unless otherwise specified in the course descriptions.

On the enclosed pages, please fill out the form with all the necessary information. We ask that you also have your child rank the electives they want included in their daily summer school schedule. There are a limited number of spaces, so the electives will be granted on a first come, first serve basis. Please make sure you specify all of the sessions your child will be attending for Summer School.

The Unity School District is a participant in the Summer Food Service Program. As a result, the District will provide free breakfast and lunch to all children 18 and under. Breakfast will be served from 7:45 a.m.-8:30 a.m., and lunch will be served from 11:00 a.m.-12:30 p.m. A free breakfast and lunch will be offered in conjunction with each session of Summer School.

## 3D Tiny House:

Chances are you have seen a tiny house. These little homes are everywhere...and now, you can make your own 3D version.

## Adventure a Day:

Every day is a different creative and intellectual challenge! Break codes, learn to do "mouflage"—creating realistic fake wounds investigate mazes, learn how police investigate a scene, and MUCH more.

## All Games All Day:

Learn fun games that you can teach others to play. Games like Scategories, Charades, and Telephone Pictionary are just a few that we will cover during the week.

## Athletic Training (7-8):

Students must be going into 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Become a better athlete and have fun while doing so. This course involves weight lifting, agility training, and various outdoor activities.

## Camping Skills:

Come join the magic of learning at Hogwarts! Discover your house, create science experiments, design your wand, build the best broomstick, & enjoy tasty treats like chocolate frogs.

## Let's Party:

Learn how to put together a party. We'll choose a theme, decorate, and make a meal plan on a budget. We will talk through etiquette of serving people and making you customer happy. By the end of the week we will throw our own party.

## Master Chef:

Dazzle your family and friends as you learn to make a multitude of recipes from snacks to meals.

## Mini Golf:

You will work in teams to design and build a real miniature golf course or arcade game in the classroom.

## Mystery Madness:

Get your detective skills ready because we have mysteries to solve! Learn the important steps to solving mysteries: fingerprinting, note-taking, interviewing, handwriting analysis, finding clues, and more. Let's solve a mystery!

## Outdoor Adventure Series:

This is a 2 week course where you will get an introduction to bicycling and experience riding trails at 3 exciting locations! Enjoy the outdoors with tubing/fishing/swimming at Half Moon Beach! Also, learn the basics of kayaking and experience kayaking in 3 different locations!

## Outdoor Survival Skills:
