

Luck School District's One-to-One Laptop Usage Agreement

Almost all careers that students will go into will require significant technological skills, including agriculture. Each student is responsible for his/her actions as he/she uses the laptop. This policy applies to all laptop use at Luck High School. Students may use their own laptops, smart phones, tablets, etc., if they wish, but during school hours or while in the building they must follow all of the guidelines and Internet protocols provided for the District's computers. Our objectives include using fewer textbooks and less paper, while providing Luck High School students with resources and an organized note-taking platform.

The laptop 1 to 1 program will be for high school (grades 9 - 12) students only. The Jr. High (grades 7 - 8) and Elementary (4Kindergarten – grade 6) students will continue to use the labs already established within the District.

Each student will be provided with a laptop which he/she will turn in at the end of each school year for maintenance. He/she will keep the same laptop throughout his/her high school career. The laptops will adhere to all limits specified by and for the District with regard to access to and use of internet websites. This includes after school hours, on weekends, and during vacations. The District's filters are in place to block out unacceptable sites. Facebook, twitter, and other social media sites, as well as online shopping sites, online gambling sites, pornography, hate, violent, and other inappropriate sites and sites that allow illegal downloading will be blocked. Teacher-specified YouTube educational sites will be accessible. Although the laptop contains a filtering device, the parents or guardians are responsible for monitoring the student's use when he/she has the laptop out of the building.

Students will be able to access their G-Mail accounts; however, other messaging sites will continue to be blocked.

Each student will be responsible for keeping his/her laptop charged. Secure charging stations will be available in the 7-12 Library, Mr. Roush's room (211) and Mr. Hetfeld's room (207). Laptops can be left in these areas for one or more class periods or overnight or over the weekend. The student must place his/her laptop in the secure slot and plug it in.

Each student will be responsible for keeping his/her laptop, cords, and charger in the laptop case provided by the District. If a student wishes to use an alternate case, he/she must show it to Ms. Nelson or Mr. Arjes to determine that it is of the same quality or better than the one provided by the District.

Each student will be responsible for keeping his/her laptop of areas with extreme temperature or humidity changes, as well as the school's cafeteria, gymnasiums, locker-rooms, bathrooms, and other areas where food and water are likely to damage it.

Each student will be responsible for securing his/her laptop which includes, but is not limited to, making sure his/her locker is properly locked when the laptop is stored within in. Laptops left in public areas will be confiscated. Repeated confiscations of any student's laptop will result in the student's loss of access to any laptop.
