Dear Luck School Alumnus,

Please join us in congratulating our 2019 Luck Alumni Scholarship recipients Katie Mattson, Ryley Fosberg, & Nancy Olave. Each will receive a \$1,000 scholarship upon completion of their first semester of post high school study, and show that they are enrolled for another semester.

Perhaps you saw the announcement last Spring regarding the **Frandsen Family Foundation Scholarship**, which promises to pay for two years of tuition to Luck graduates who attend a technical college. The scholarship covers any remaining tuition and fees after the student's Federal Pell Grant and WI State Grant have been applied to the student's account.

As a result, 31 out of 35 Luck 2019 graduates were accepted by FFFS, which left us with only 3 applicants for our LAFSA scholarship. This allowed us to increase the LAFSA scholarship amount to \$1,000 each.

The Frandsen Family Foundation Scholarship will be in place again for 2020 graduates, and the LAFSA board will meet to determine scholarship amounts for our 2020 applicants. The ripple effect of the FFFS scholarships allow us to make a bigger impact on the students we do award as well as build for the future.

RE: CARDINAL SAFETY NEST

The Luck Alumni Scholarship Foundation, Inc (LASFI) was formed in 2009, to raise money for graduating seniors. So far, the single best way to raise these funds is through our annual “ask” letter. Some donors have taken the time to fill out comments when sending in their donations, and we realized there was getting to be a common theme: Donors want to do more than just help graduating seniors.

As a response to those comments, the following programs are in process.

For the past 3 years, the Luck Alumni Scholarship Fund has provided \$500 to the Luck School for classroom supplies. This money buys supplies needed daily by both students and teachers and helps close a gap between school funding and daily needs.

We have also started a new program has been named the Cardinal Safety Nest and has the full support from Luck School Administration. The Luck Alumni Scholarship Foundation is starting the program with a \$1,000 donation, which is separate from the \$500 already given for classroom supply needs.

At our 2019 Spring Meeting, it was decided that we will donate some money back to the School, to be used by all teachers if they have a student in special need. Since teachers often know exactly who these students are, we have come up with a simple request form to be submit to the Community Education Coordinator when a need arises. At this point, our board views the funds going for things like field trips, backpacks, clothing, lunch money, etc. We hope to help students overcome hardships they face.

Our vision for future funding for the Cardinal Safety Nest will be an online campaign specific to the “nest” project. We believe as word of this new program spreads, more and more will want to contribute to help our local School children, and not necessarily only a graduating senior.

For now, our annual ask letter will continue to fund scholarship dollars, more to come on a special campaign for the Cardinal Safety Nest.

Coming soon is the creation of a Luck Alumni Wall of Honor. This idea will encourage nominations of past and present faculty & students for special recognition. While we are in the beginning planning stage for this project, we have set a goal to announce our first inductees at graduation in the Spring of 2020.
