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Hello Luck Families,

We are surely in a new and unprecedented situation. The staff at Luck School are committed to helping students grow and remain on track to take the next steps in their education. We are determined to continue to help students grow academically, remind them that we care about them, and foster the approach of teaching the whole child. After discussion with our school board, we have developed the following process for grading for students in grades 6-12. This process will only be used for trimester three of this school year.

Students will be graded on a Pass/Incomplete platform. As always, our goal in grading is to attempt to determine the successful accomplishment of learning targets based on the essential questions we have established in our classes. However, some learning targets and essential questions cannot be measured due to the correspondence method of instruction and delivery we are being forced to use. As a result, teachers will be using the data available to them to determine if a student is growing and accomplishing enough of the learning targets to pass a course. If so, a student will have earned a P. At the high school level, they will then earn the corresponding half credit for that course. Students who are enrolled in courses from institutions other than Luck will be graded by the guidelines for those institutions, for example, a student taking an online college course through a college.

Since we are committed to student growth, students who fall short of passing will earn an incomplete. We will provide as many options for resolving that incomplete as we are allowed to under COVID guidelines. We will continue to offer correspondence opportunities throughout the summer and, if able, will have face to face opportunities as we are allowed under the guidelines. Students will have until August 30 to resolve the incomplete.

Once school begins in the Fall, any incompletes remaining will be officially posted to report cards. If a student wishes to have that incomplete removed from their report card, or they need the course for graduation requirements, they may retake the course, during the 2020-21 school year, and have the incomplete replaced with a "P".
